CHURCH HISTORY

Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church was forged by God and founded by Pastor JT and Evangelist Lakithia Chapman on May 1, 2016. The first worship service was held at the Apex Community Center 53 Hunter Street Apex, NC. Over 150 persons gathered to share in this new worship effort. Dr. John T Chapman preached the first sermon at Peak City FGBC entitled, "Let the Healing Begin." A reflection of God's favor, the first worship service was adorned with uplifting praise and worship, attentive ushers, melodies from the Peak City Choir concluding with worshipers partaking of the Lord's Supper. After the first worship service ended, the gatherers visited a 10,000 plus square foot property located at 1701 Center Street in Apex NC. A week later, this location would become the first home of Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church. While new members worked diligently on the renovations of the new property, worship was conducted at the Hilton Garden Inn on Columbus Drive in Cary NC. The first worship service in the new edifice was held on May 22nd, 2016. The attendance and excitement continues to grow with each passing week. The church considers this new ministry as the Lord's doing. To God be the Glory for the things He has done. The best is yet to come!




I Dwell in a Place of Peace!

Make no mistake about it, there are so many things that we could worry about: children, job, finances, health, business and ministry. You name it, and there is an opportunity to worry about it. But, I HAVE A WONDERFUL IDEA! Don't name it. How about not focusing on what could go wrong. Don't dwell in the land of fear, doubt and unbelief. Job said "For the thing which I fear cometh upon me, and that which I am afraid of cometh unto me." So don't focus on what could go wrong because God wants you to dwell in PEACE.

Anytime something surfaces to transport you from your place of peace, say NO! I will not worry. No! I will not allow ominous thoughts of depression to dominate my mind. No! I refuse to allow the fear of what could, might or would happen to bully me into a place of inferiority. NO! I DWELL IN A PLACE OF PEACE and always will.

This week's lesson will help you focus on *dwelling in a place of peace*. So, while you are reading, keep your focus on the subject: "I Dwell in a Place of Peace." Come on. Say it aloud if you believe it: I dwell in a place of peace. WOW, you certainly sound convincing. Enjoy this week's lesson!

I Dwell in a Place of Peace! - (KJV)

Monday: Psalms 4: 1-8

1. Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.
2. O ye sons of men, how long will ye turn my glory into shame? how long will ye love vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah.
3. But know that the Lord hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the Lord will hear when I call unto him.
4. Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.
5. Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the Lord.
6. There be many that say, Who will shew us any good? Lord, lift thou up the light of thy countenance upon us.
7. Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than in the time that their corn and their wine increased.
8. I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, Lord, only makest me dwell in safety.

Tuesday: Psalms 29: 1-11

1. Ascribe unto Jehovah, O ye sons of the mighty, Ascribe unto Jehovah glory and strength.
2. Ascribe unto Jehovah the glory due unto his name; Worship Jehovah in holy array.
3. The voice of Jehovah is upon the waters: The God of glory thundereth, Even Jehovah

upon many waters.

4. The voice of Jehovah is powerful; The voice of Jehovah is full of majesty.
5. The voice of Jehovah breaketh the cedars; Yea, Jehovah breaketh in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.
6. He maketh them also to skip like a calf; Lebanon and Sirion like a young wild-ox.
7. The voice of Jehovah cleaveth the flames of fire.
8. The voice of Jehovah shaketh the wilderness; Jehovah shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh.
9. The voice of Jehovah maketh the hinds to calve, And strippeth the forests bare: And in his temple everything saith, Glory.
10. Jehovah sat as King at the Flood; Yea, Jehovah sitteth as King for ever.
11. Jehovah will give strength unto his people; Jehovah will bless his people with peace.

Wednesday: Psalms 37: 1-11

1. Fret not thyself because of evil-doers, Neither be thou envious against them that work unrighteousness.
2. For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, And wither as the green herb.
3. Trust in Jehovah, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on his faithfulness.
4. Delight thyself also in Jehovah; And he will give thee the desires of thy heart.
5. Commit thy way unto Jehovah; Trust also in him, and he will bring it to pass.
6. And he will make thy righteousness to go forth as the light, And thy justice as the noon-day.
7. Rest in Jehovah, and wait patiently for him: Fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, Because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.
8. Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: Fret not thyself, it tendeth only to evil-doing.
9. For evil-doers shall be cut off; But those that wait for Jehovah, they shall inherit the land.
10. For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: Yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and he shall not be.
11. But the meek shall inherit the land, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

Thursday: Psalms 122: 1-9

1. I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go unto the house of Jehovah.
2. Our feet are standing Within thy gates, O Jerusalem,
3. Jerusalem, that art builded As a city that is compact together;
4. Whither the tribes go up, even the tribes of Jehovah, For an ordinance for Israel, To give thanks unto the name of Jehovah.
5. For there are set thrones for judgment, The thrones of the house of David.
6. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: They shall prosper that love thee.
7. Peace be within thy walls, And prosperity within thy palaces.
8. For my brethren and companions' sakes, I will now say, Peace be within thee.
9. For the sake of the house of Jehovah our God I will seek thy good.

Friday: Matthew 5: 1-9

1. And seeing the multitudes, he went up into the mountain: and when he had sat down, his disciples came unto him:
2. and he opened his mouth and taught them, saying,
3. Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
4. Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
5. Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
6. Blessed are they that hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
7. Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
8. Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
9. Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called sons of God.

Saturday: John 14: 18-27

18. I will not leave you desolate: I come unto you.
19. Yet a little while, and the world beholdeth me no more; but ye behold me: because I live, ye shall live also.
20. In that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.
21. He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself unto him.
22. Judas (not Iscariot) saith unto him, Lord, what is come to pass that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?
23. Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my word: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.
24. He that loveth me not keepeth not my words: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's who sent me.
25. These things have I spoken unto you, while yet abiding with you.
26. But the Comforter, even the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said unto you.
27. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be fearful.

Sunday: Romans 14: 11-17

11. For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, to me every knee shall bow, And every tongue shall confess to God.
12. So then each one of us shall give account of himself to God.
13. Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge ye this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock in his brother's way, or an occasion of falling.
14. I know, and am persuaded in the Lord Jesus, that nothing is unclean of itself: save that to him who accounteth anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.
15. For if because of meat thy brother is grieved, thou walkest no longer in love. Destroy not with thy meat him for whom Christ died.
16. Let not then your good be evil spoken of:
17. for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
