CHURCH HISTORY

Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church was forged by God and founded by Pastor JT and Evangelist Lakithia Chapman on May 1, 2016. The first worship service was held at the Apex Community Center 53 Hunter Street Apex, NC. Over 150 persons gathered to share in this new worship effort. Dr. John T Chapman preached the first sermon at Peak City FGBC entitled, "Let the Healing Begin." A reflection of God's favor, the first worship service was adorned with uplifting praise and worship, attentive ushers, melodies from the Peak City Choir concluding with worshipers partaking of the Lord's Supper. After the first worship service ended, the gatherers visited a 10,000 plus square foot property located at 1701 Center Street in Apex NC. A week later, this location would become the first home of Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church. While new members worked diligently on the renovations of the new property, worship was conducted at the Hilton Garden Inn on Columbus Drive in Cary NC. The first worship service in the new edifice was held on May 22nd, 2016. The attendance and excitement continues to grow with each passing week. The church considers this new ministry as the Lord's doing. To God be the Glory for the things He has done. The best is yet to come!

Get Over It!

How is your endurance? How do you handle adversity? Are you easily provoked? These questions are all relevant when considering the combative nature of life. Life will always present you with challenges that require some amount of focus and attention. So, when you square up, shoulder-to-shoulder with the challenge, how will you respond? Will you allow the problem to dominate your thoughts? Will you allow the challenge to consume you? Will you issue an all-access pass to grief, gloom and despair because you are facing some tension? How will you handle the adversity?

Needless to say, I have a suggestion: GET OVER IT! That's right. Get over it. For too long, good people have allowed challenges to dictate their every thought, move and mood. But this week we say, no more! No more getting into my head that thing that God has already resolved. No more watching the beautiful days God has given come and go without celebrating the fact that I am still alive! No more letting short-lived problems have a lasting impression upon my life. Yes! When something-anything-manifest as an obstruction and partition in my life, I AM GOING TO GET OVER IT!

This week's lesson will help you scale wall-like problems and get over what once defied you even to confront. So, while you are reading, keep your focus on the subject: "Get Over It." When you safely reach the other side of that issue, don't hesitate to declare: Ha! Ha! I got over!

Get Over It! - (KJV)

Monday: I Cor. 15: 55-58

55. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?
56. The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.
57. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
58. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

Tuesday: Romans 8: 12-18

12. Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.
13. For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
14. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
15. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
16. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:
17. And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.
18. For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Wednesday: Romans 8: 35-39

35. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
36. As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.
37. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
38. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,
39. Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Thursday: 1 John 4: 1-4

1. Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
2. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:
3. And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
4. Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

Friday: Phil. 4: 11-13

11. Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.
12. I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.
13. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Saturday: I Cor. 10: 12-13

12. Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall.
13. There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

Sunday: Proverbs 24: 1-10

1. Be not thou envious against evil men, neither desire to be with them.
2. For their heart studieth destruction, and their lips talk of mischief.
3. Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established:
4. And by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches.
5. A wise man is strong; yea, a man of knowledge increaseth strength.
6. For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors there is safety.
7. Wisdom is too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.
8. He that deviseth to do evil shall be called a mischievous person.
9. The thought of foolishness is sin: and the scorner is an abomination to men.
10. If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small.
