CHURCH HISTORY

Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church was forged by God and founded by Pastor JT and Evangelist Lakithia Chapman on May 1, 2016. The first worship service was held at the Apex Community Center 53 Hunter Street Apex, NC. Over 150 persons gathered to share in this new worship effort. Dr. John T Chapman preached the first sermon at Peak City FGBC entitled, "Let the Healing Begin." A reflection of God's favor, the first worship service was adorned with uplifting praise and worship, attentive ushers, melodies from the Peak City Choir concluding with worshipers partaking of the Lord's Supper. After the first worship service ended, the gatherers visited a 10,000 plus square foot property located at 1701 Center Street in Apex NC. A week later, this location would become the first home of Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church. While new members worked diligently on the renovations of the new property, worship was conducted at the Hilton Garden Inn on Columbus Drive in Cary NC. The first worship service in the new edifice was held on May 22nd, 2016. The attendance and excitement continues to grow with each passing week. The church considers this new ministry as the Lord's doing. To God be the Glory for the things He has done. The best is yet to come!




Saturday: 2 Timothy 2: 1-3:

HOLD ON TO WHAT YOU BELEIVE!

Do you have desires? Do have things that you want to come to pass? Sure you do. We all do. If it were as simple as having a desire and then receiving it without delay, there would be no need for this week's lesson.

The truth is there remains negative thoughts, negative people and adverse situations that cloud our beautiful sky of life. When this happens, you should simply hold on to what you believe. This week's lesson will help you do exactly that.

There will be responses and reactions of rejection that manifest the moment you decide to move forward. However, we do not give up the moment adversity shows up. But rather we overcome evil with good. The bible says, *God will give you the desires of your heart*. Hence, the desire you have-in align with God's desires-did not come to you in a vacuum. Your Creator planted these desires in your spirit. So, **HOLD ON TO WHAT YOU BELEIVE!** While you are reading this week, keep your focus on the subject: "Hold On To What You Believe." Keep a tight grip.

HOLD ON TO WHAT YOU BELEIVE! - (KJV)

Monday: Gen 25: 21-26:

21. And Isaac intreated the Lord for his wife, because she was barren: and the Lord was intreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived.
22. And the children struggled together within her; and she said, If it be so, why am I thus? And she went to inquire of the Lord.
23. And the Lord said unto her, Two nations are in thy womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.
24. And when her days to be delivered were fulfilled, behold, there were twins in her womb.
25. And the first came out red, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau.
26. And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was threescore years old when she bare them.

Tuesday: Genesis 25: 27-34:

27. And the boys grew: and Esau was a cunning hunter, a man of the field; and Jacob was a plain man, dwelling in tents.
28. And Isaac loved Esau, because he did eat of his venison: but Rebekah loved Jacob.
29. And Jacob sod pottage: and Esau came from the field, and he was faint.
30. And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red pottage; for I am faint: therefore was his name called Edom.
31. And Jacob said, Sell me this day thy birthright.
32. And Esau said, Behold, I am at the point to die: and what profit shall this birthright do to
