CHURCH HISTORY

Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church was forged by God and founded by Pastor JT and Evangelist Lakithia Chapman on May 1, 2016. The first worship service was held at the Apex Community Center 53 Hunter Street Apex, NC. Over 150 persons gathered to share in this new worship effort. Dr. John T Chapman preached the first sermon at Peak City FGBC entitled, "Let the Healing Begin." A reflection of God's favor, the first worship service was adorned with uplifting praise and worship, attentive ushers, melodies from the Peak City Choir concluding with worshipers partaking of the Lord's Supper. After the first worship service ended, the gatherers visited a 10,000 plus square foot property located at 1701 Center Street in Apex NC. A week later, this location would become the first home of Peak City Full Gospel Baptist Church. While new members worked diligently on the renovations of the new property, worship was conducted at the Hilton Garden Inn on Columbus Drive in Cary NC. The first worship service in the new edifice was held on May 22nd, 2016. The attendance and excitement continues to grow with each passing week. The church considers this new ministry as the Lord's doing. To God be the Glory for the things He has done. The best is yet to come!

Wednesday: Luke 17: 1-5:

Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe unto him, through whom they come! 2 It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones. 3 Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. 4 And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him. 5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.

Thursday: II Cor. 2: 4-8:

4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you.

5 But if any have caused grief, he hath not grieved me, but in part: that I may not overcharge you all. 6 Sufficient to such a man is this punishment, which was inflicted of many. 7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. 8 Wherefore I beseech you that ye would confirm your love toward him.

Friday: 2 Cor 2: 5-11:

5 But if any have caused grief, he hath not grieved me, but in part: that I may not overcharge you all. 6 Sufficient to such a man is this punishment, which was inflicted of many. 7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. 8 Wherefore I beseech you that ye would confirm your love toward him. 9 For to this end also did I write, that I might know the proof of you, whether ye be obedient in all things. 10 To whom ye forgive any thing, I forgive also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ; 11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

Saturday: Eph 4: 29-32:

29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. 30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. 31 Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: 32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Sunday: I John 1: 8-9:

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Let It Go! (KJV)

I am sure that we have all done things that we regret. I know that I have felt awful for past mistakes, especially for the mistakes involving others. But when one is at fault he remedy--to me--seems clear: Just apologize. I'll be the first to admit that I have dished out more than my share of apologies. It was difficult; but, necessary nonetheless.

On the other hand, when I am on the receiving end of the offense, the tables turn. As a Christian, am I really expected to do what the person (who is at fault) should do? Why should I have to be the bigger person? I am the one insulted. Yet, I am told that I must display an emotion that at the moment is not available to me?

Even though forgiveness, at times, can be a challenge, I have found that releasing the offender from the wrongdoing is wonderful therapy for the offended. We have enough things we must contend with than to add more to our plates.

So, when confronted with an offense, do yourself a favor and forgive. There are those who have done you wrong, but there is nothing wrong with letting them off the hook. To forgive does more for you, than it does for them. Learn the lesson from the experience and move on. Just let it go.

While you are reading this week, keep your focus on the subject: Let It Go! Enjoy your reading and forgive.

Monday: Genesis 50: 15-20:

15 And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him. 16 And they sent a messenger unto Joseph, saying, Thy father did command before he died, saying, 17 So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him. 18 And his brethren also went and fell down before his face; and they said, Behold, we be thy servants. 19 And Joseph said unto them, Fear not: for am I in the place of God? 20 But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is t! his day, to save much people alive.

Tuesday: Luke 11: 1-4:

And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples. 2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. 3 Give us day by day our daily bread. 4 And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.
